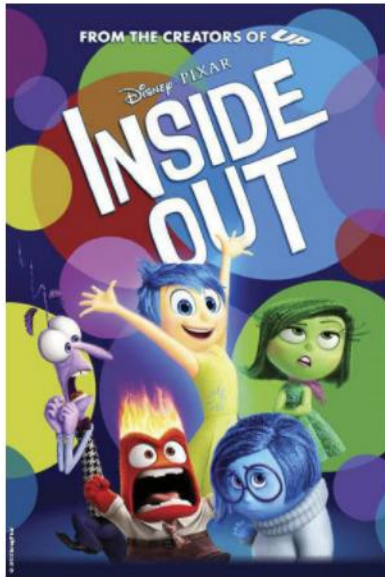

St. Joseph Outreach Ministry Update

We would like to update parishioners on the status of our Saint Joseph Outreach Program. Between October 1, 2023 and June 30, 2024 our participation in the Saint Vincent DePaul Consortium has helped 200 individuals to pay their utilities and housing. The majority of our clients have experienced serious health conditions which greatly impaired their ability to work. All cases are investigated by Catholic Charities for legitimacy. If approved, then financial aid pledging begins. Saint Joseph has contributed \$3,325 toward a requested \$69,200. Payments are made directly to utilities and mortgage lenders. Money is never given to an individual.

These figures are for the cases in which we participated, but the total number of cases and the money disbursed by the Consortium as a whole was much higher.
